



**DECISION No MB/2014/6 WP
of the Management Board
of the European Union Agency for Network
and Information Security (ENISA)
adopting Rules Implementing Staff Regulations**

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF ENISA,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 526/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 May 2013 concerning the European Union Agency for Network and Information Security and repealing Regulation (EC) No 460/2004 and in particular Article 5 (8) thereof.

Having regard to the Regulation No 31 (EEC), 11 (EAEC), laying down the Staff Regulations of Officials and Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community ("Staff Regulations"), and in particular Article 110 thereof.

Having regard to the decisions of the European Commission setting up implementing rules for application of the Staff Regulations.

Whereas the Staff Regulations provides that implementing rules shall enter into force at the agencies nine months after their entry into force at the European Commission or nine months after the date on which the European Commission informed the agencies of the adoption of the respective implementing rule, whichever is later.

Whereas the Staff Committee of European Union Agency for Network and Information Security ("ENISA") has been consulted.

Whereas the minutes of the Executive Board meeting dated on 7 May 2014 record the Executive Board's unanimous agreement on the proposal to adopt the general implementing rules of the Staff Regulation by analogy to the staff of ENISA.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Decision MB/2014/5 WP of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Network and Information Security (ENISA) adopting the attached Rules Implementing Staff Regulations herein shall be annulled.

Article 2

The general implementing rules of the Staff Regulation, as adopted by the European Commission on 16th December 2013, and listed in Annex I, shall apply by analogy to the staff of the ENISA.



Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption. It shall apply as from 30th September 2014.
