Level of assurance high

- The wallet shall meet the requirements set out in CIR (EU) 2015/1502, for (eIDAS) assurance level ‘high’

High	<p>Level substantial, plus:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The electronic identification means protects against duplication and tampering as well as against attackers with high attack potential
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- Link between EUCC and CSA level of assurance

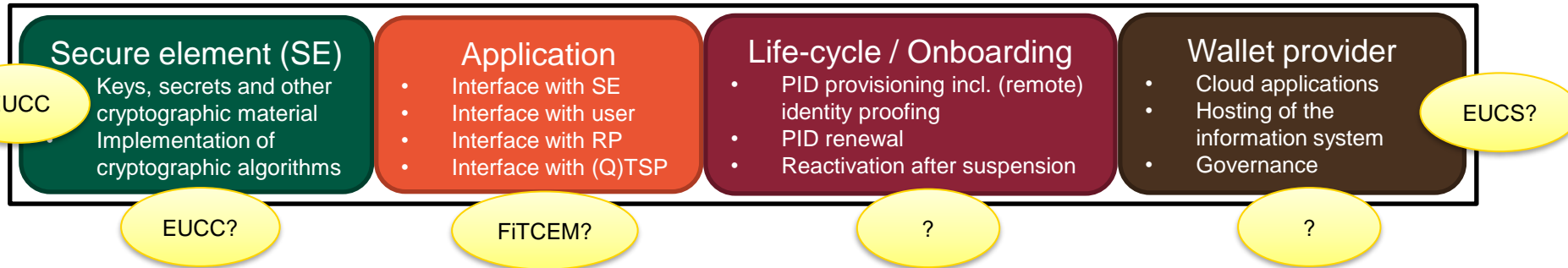
Vulnerability Component	TOE resistant to attacker with attack potential of:	Residual vulnerabilities only exploitable by attacker with attack potential of:
VAN.5	High	Beyond High
VAN.4	Moderate	High
VAN.3	Enhanced-Basic	Moderate
VAN.2	Basic	Enhanced-Basic
VAN.1	Basic	Enhanced-Basic

} CSA assurance level ‘Substantial’
