Harmonization and the eIDAS Regulation

Lesson learnt from "eIDAS 1.0": We need stronger harmonization




One Goal of the new eIDAS Regulation is the completion of a European trust space by harmonizing and clarifying the rules for trust service providers (TSPs) across the EU and ensuring that the same rules are applied in the same way across the EU





Article 19 sets harmonized security requirements for trust service providers and one supervisory body in each member state







Future regulation with NIS Directive 2.0

The NIS 2.0 **Directive** proposed by the European Commission in December 2020 is intended to including trust services and electronic communications networks and services within the scope of this directive. Thus, the security requirements of the eIDAS regulation are to be replaced by those of the NIS 2.0 directive.



All the questions and problems will have to be taken into national law, which is proving to be the real challenge



The requirements must be replaced by **27 national laws** in a regulation that is directly applicable to all member states and thus the conformity assessment for qualified trust services will become many times more complex

1. Standardized Audit



2. Coordinated Supervisory Authorities



3. Europeanwide Harmonized Single Auditreport for all NCAs



Requirements for eIDAS 2.0

eIDAS 2.0 Proposal

- The required conformity assessment according to eIDAS article 20 should be performed in one audit report
- Standardized requirements and audits are necessary
- Conformity assessment have to according to adjusted/amended ETSI Standards
