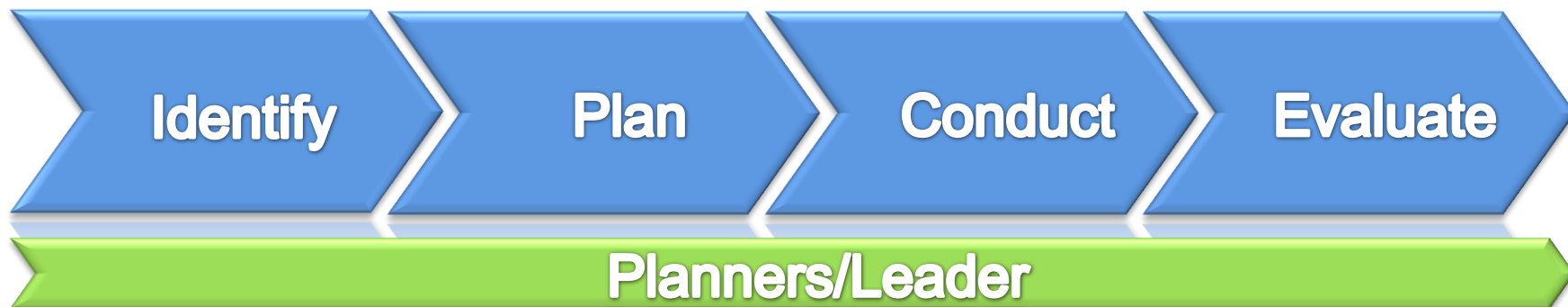
Outcomes of 1st EFMS Meeting

- ★ main objective to pan EU exercise - enhance MS' coordination efforts during crisis
- ★ focus on communication channels and/or points of contacts
- ★ start simple and pragmatic, be open and transparent to all MS (e.g. table-top exercise)
- ★ goal of 2010 very ambitious
- ★ step-by-step approach followed by a roadmap
- ★ experienced MS full fledge members, less experienced MS observers
- ★ private sector has a key role to success
- ★ ENISA
 - ★ facilitate information sharing & good practices regarding national exercises
 - ★ prepare a good practice guide on national exercises
 - ★ facilitating role in the development of a pan European exercise
- ★ JRC provides operational and infrastructural support to run the exercise





ENISA's GPG - Roles and Steps



- ★ Plans and co-ordinates the whole process
- ★ Identifies the needs and the objectives
- ★ Acts upon the strategic advice & recommendations of the steering committee
 - ★ size, scope, measures to test
 - ★ scenario
 - ★ format of the exercise
 - ★ profile of participants – recruitment
 - ★ role of external, subject matter experts
 - ★ moderators, monitors and evaluators and their processes
 - ★ media involvement
- ★ Plans and Moderates the whole process





ENISA's GPG - Roles and Steps

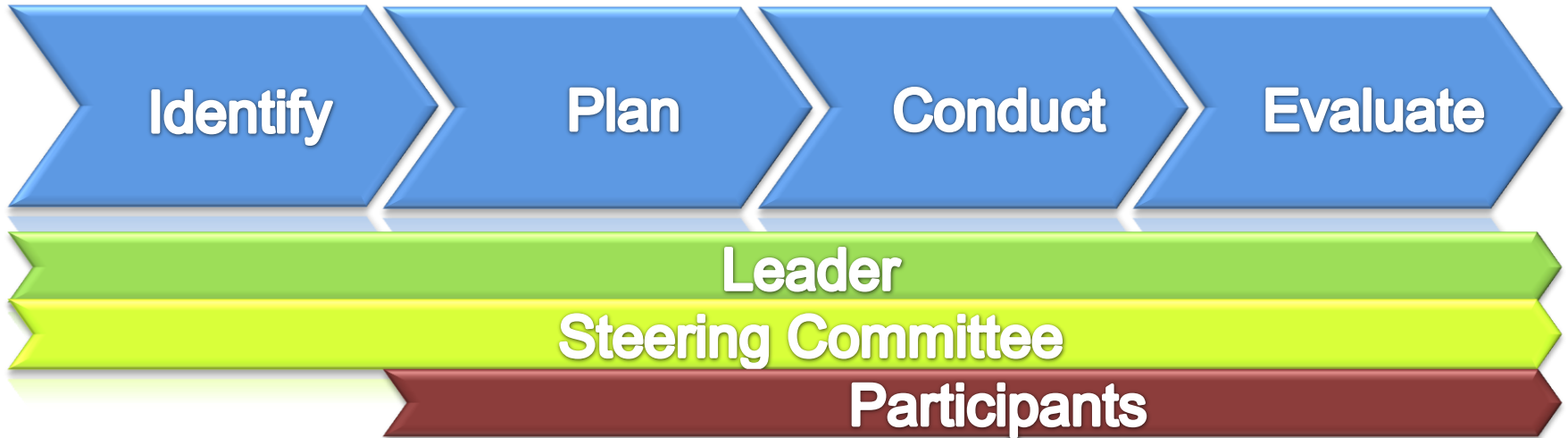


- ★ Provides vision and direction
- ★ Decides on alternative scenarios
- ★ Identifies measures to test
- ★ Engages participants
- ★





ENISA's GPG - Roles and Steps

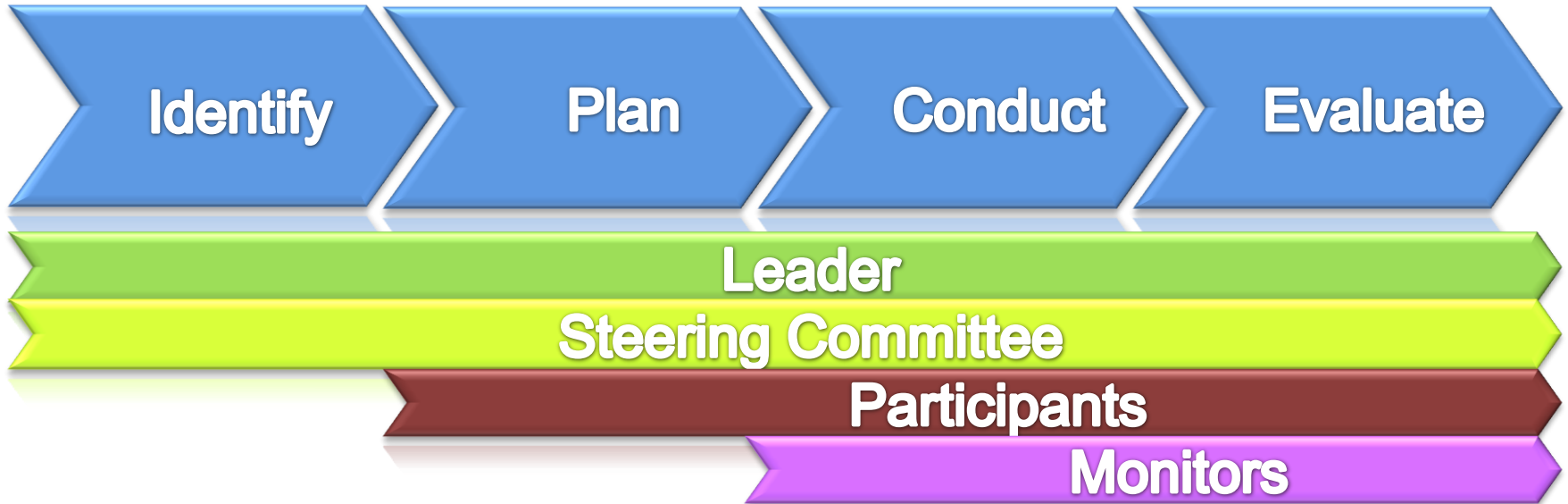


- ★ Have key role in the tested measures
- ★ Involved in planning
 - ★ Those individuals will not participate in the exercise
- ★ Commit resources
- ★ Different levels of experience





ENISA's GPG - Roles and Steps

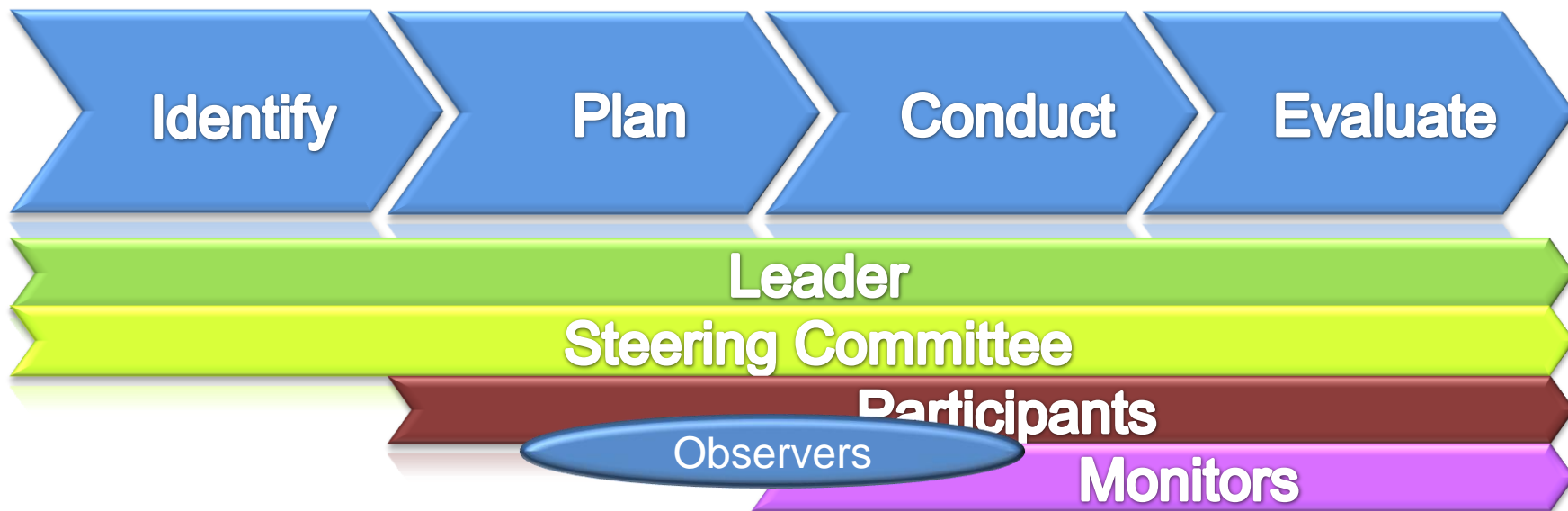


- ★ Internal or external
 - ★ Experience is important, training is essential
- ★ Observe and evaluate participants' actions, decisions, and effectiveness
- ★ Report to moderators
- ★ Relay injects
- ★ Answer questions
- ★ Provide input for the evaluation





ENISA's GPG - Roles and Steps

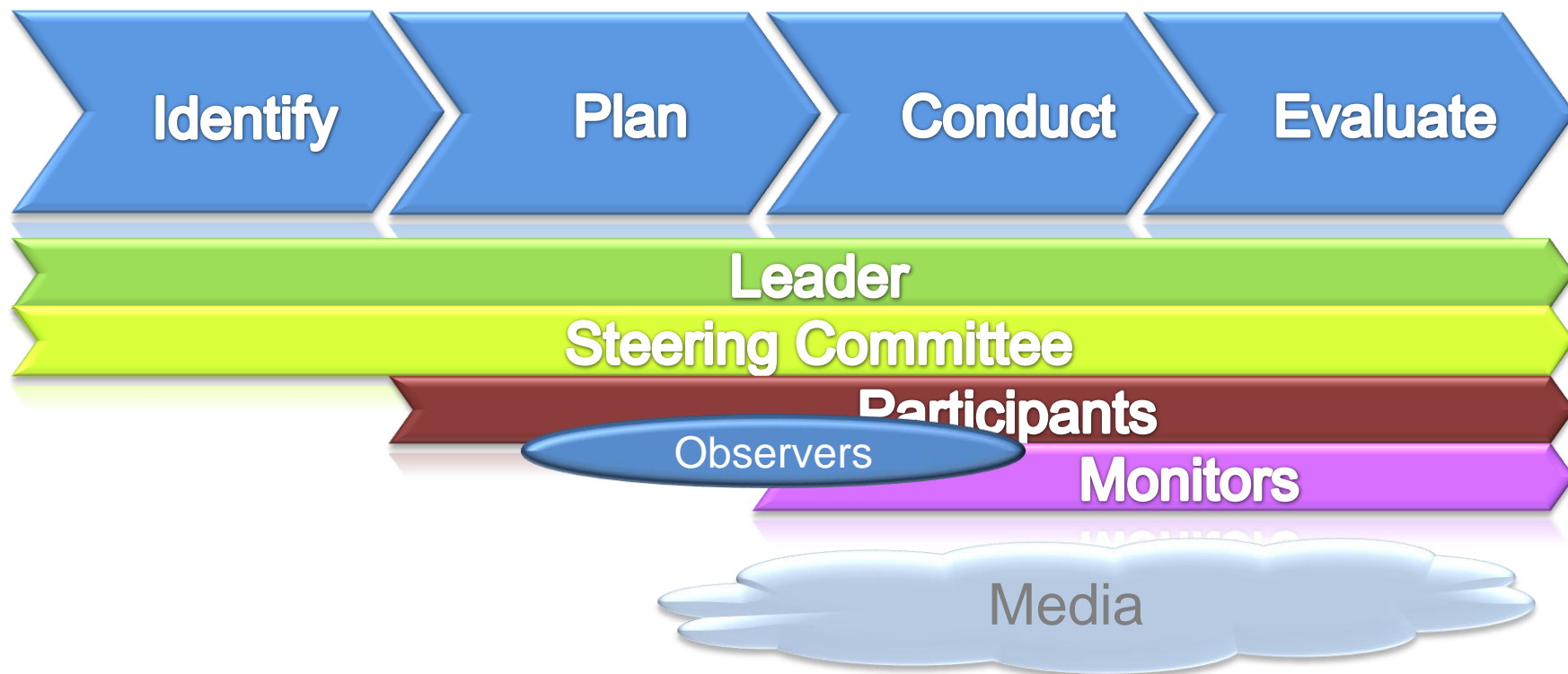


- ★ Do not influence the decisions
- ★ Provide input and receive knowledge
- ★ Do not have access to all details





ENISA's GPG - Roles and Steps



- ★ Their role is determined during planning
- ★ Receive the public report





Next Steps

- ★ engage stakeholders through one or more workshops
 - ★ identify planners/leader
 - ★ empower planners/leader
 - ★ form a steering committee
 - ★ develop alternative scenarios/measures to test
 - ★ decide on financial resources
 - ★ identify possible participants, observers and evaluators
- ★ develop a roadmap with clear steps and deadlines
- ★ follow up a well defined framework (e.g. ENISA's Good Practice guide)
