Skills Gap – People lacking the appropriate Skills

- Approx 50% of Businesses have a Skills gap
- 160,000 vacancies – Employment is increasing at 10% annually
- Annual Shortfall of c. 14,000
- Lack of Career Pathways – Confusion - Language

Skills Shortage – Number of people available to work in Cyber Security Roles

- 3-5 Years experience are the most difficult to fill (60% of postings 2-6 yrs)
- Salaries – Benefits – Training and Development – Culture – Job Satisfaction
- Diversity
